

MINISTER HELD ON MANN ACT CHARGE

Rev. Finis Dake, Pastor of Zion, Ill., Church, Denies Accusation.

Chicago, May 27. (AP)—United States Commissioner Edwin Walker today ordered the Rev. Finis Jennings Dake, 35 year old pastor of the Christian Assembly church of Zion, Ill., removed to Milwaukee for trial in the Federal court there on charges of violating the Mann act.

The blonde, six foot pastor did not deny the charge in court, but afterwards told questioners that there was no truth in the government's allegation that he took Emma Barelli, 16, from her home town of Kenosha, Wis., to East St. Louis, Ill., for immoral purposes.

Attorneys for the minister, said

they would post the bail of \$2,000.

Mrs. Dake, also an ordained minister, defended her husband, saying Miss Barelli was a hitch hiker whom the minister took to East St. Louis to give a home with his sister. Mrs. Dake said she had met the girl.

The Rev. Mr. Dake and his wife are the parents of an 8 year old daughter, Finitte.
